

ABOUT US



The University of Physical Education is facing of its greatest development opportunities since being established in 1925. Besides renewing the educational content, our university has the possibility to be part of a major infrastructure development project. As a result of the modern curriculum, the multifunctional sports facilities and the community space, students have the opportunity to enrich themselves with memories and get competitive knowledge during their university years.

The University of Physical Education is one of the oldest and most successful higher education institutions in the field of physical education. It preserves its traditions, but also meets the requirements of our age by providing a broad knowledge in the field of physical education. There are only a few universities in the world where practice and sport science are being combined at such high level. The initial goal of the institution was teacher training in physical education, which later on has further developed into coach training. Due to the fast development of

physical education and the world of sport, new departments had been organized, new courses had become part of the curriculum such as recreation, human kinesiology and sport management. The University of Physical Education is the only university in Hungary providing doctoral training in sport science. Coaches of a number of Olympic-, World-, and European Champions have completed their studies at the University of Physical Education. The Hungarian University Sports Federation places strong emphasis upon giving Hungary a chance to organize international university sports events in order to increase Hungarian universities' and the country's international reputation. It is a great pleasure that Hungary has won the right to organize the 6th European Universities Bridge Championship. This will be an outstanding event for junior



sports organized by the University of Physical Education and the Hungarian University Sports Federation. Bridge is an entertaining sport which started developing in the sixties and seventies in Hungary, and at that time became popular at the universities, too. That generation still provides the majority of competitors.

Since 2001, bridge became acknowledged and sponsored by the state in Hungary. The International Olympic Committee recognizes bridge as a sport and since 2008, it has been listed on the program of the Mind Sports Olympiad.

We hope that the bridge competitors representing the Hungarian universities will perform well at this international competition.

pionship in 2019. Our federation pays special attention to junior sport, which is why we support the project of the 4th European Universities Chess Championship organized in collaboration with the Hungarian University Sports Federation and the University of Physical Education.

There have been several prestigious chess competitions organized in Hungary so far. The first momentous international championship in Budapest was held in 1896, the year of Millennial celebrations in Hungary. Chess is closely related to scientific life: in the 20th century, the Nobel Prize winning Albert Szent-Györgyi was the president of the Chess Club of Szeged city; and among others the former president of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences, Prof. Szilveszter E. Vizi competed when he was a student. Apart from them many highly recognized members of Hungarian academic and scientific life were related to chess and regularly competed in individual and team competitions. We hope that this university tournament will give Hungary a notable international rank, and will also help sharing Hungary's global reputation, so we can finally fulfill our dream to organize the Chess Olympiad in the near future.

THE EVENT, THE VENUE

European Universities Championships are university sports competitions governed by the European University Sports Association.

The championships have been organised annually since 2001. Since 2012, they are organised on a biannual basis, with European Universities Games being organised in even years as multi-sport events, and the individual championships being organised in odd years.

In 2017 and 2019, bridge and chess championships are organised together due to both being 'mind sports'.

The competition will be held at the new campus of the University of Physical Education.

The infrastructural development project is currently in progress. Over 90 000 m² facility is under construction and also at Csörsz Street a multifunctional sports hall (mobile stands for 1500 people), a weight room, a gym, a 400 meter, 8 lane outdoor athletic filed (mobile stands for 350 people), a 60x100 meter soccer field with a stand which can fit 200 people, and a 1182 m² outdoor sports field. There will also be an underground parking area for 204 cars, 5 motorcycles, bike racks for 114 bicycles, and a polyclinic.

The facilities at Alkotás Street include a dormitory for 400 students, a four-star sports hotel for 100 guests, an indoor athletic field, a 25x50 meter indoor swimming pool, a gymnastics hall, an indoor sports hall, fencing and a combat hall, a range and a sports terrace with outdoor sport fields and service areas. An underground parking area will also be located here.
